There was some confusion and dismay at the start of the evening when a man (to all outward appearances at least) arrived with two lesbian friends. His entry wasn't challenged at the door as it appeared he might have come as an invited guest. We learnt later that all three had come to the trivia night under the impression that it was going to be a fundraiser.

In the unlikely event (it has never happened before!) that a man turns up for any future event, we will make it immediately clear to them that Ten Forty is a lesbian social group and that their presence at our gatherings is not welcome.
